With a very minimal demand in hemp for fiber, they decided to turn their fields to high CBD hemp farms. Their genetics team instantly saw the potential of high CBD hemp, and decided to dedicate their resources toward helping other farmers benefit from this crop, as well. They knew they could introduce farmers to new opportunities since the hemp and CBD market recently gained momentum, thanks to the newly passed 2018 farm bill. After planting their genetics and receiving amazing results in 2018, they were prepared to help all farmers produce a successful hemp crop. They shared their expertise with growers from small greenhouses with ten clones all the way up to sprawling farms with thousands of acres. This was when the Colorado Breeders Depot vision started paving the path toward the multi-state operation it is today.

The Colorado Breeders Depot in-house genetics program puts a huge focus on tri-crop industrial hemp farming, using their feminized seeds. This industrial hemp strain that used to test with only 2% CBD, has been bred up to a whopping 12% CBD, thanks to the Colorado Breeders Depot breeding program. This is just one great example of the many versatile varieties that the team hopes to offer to farmers nationally. Colorado Breeder Depot prides itself in its lab tested, high quality CBD seeds.
